Australia Act 1986

An Act to bring constitutional arrangements affecting the Commonwealth and the States into conformity with the status of the Commonwealth of Australia as a sovereign, independent and federal nation

(Queen of Australia in a geographical sense)

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Termination of power of Parliament of United Kingdom to legislate for

Australia

Australian court. (Political Parties created their High Court of Australia in 1979)

“Australian court” means a court of a State or any other court of Australia or of a Territory ----

Acts Interpretation Act (Clth) from 1973 forward.

Section: 17 Constitutional and official definitions

In any Act, unless the contrary intention appears:

" (a) ' Australia ' or the Commonwealth means the Commonwealth of Australia and, when used in a geographical sense, does not include an external Territory;"-----

unless the contrary intention appears:

- Australia in a geographical sense
- Commonwealth in a geographical sense
- Commonwealth of Australia in a geographical sense
- Australian court in a geographical sense
- court of Australia in a geographical sense



Preamble

WHEREAS the people of the States-----humbly relying on the blessing of Almighty God,-----unite in one indissoluble Federal Commonwealth-----under the Crown of the United Kingdom of Great Britain-----under the Constitution hereby established:

Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act 1901 Proclaimed and Gazetted Clause 6 Definitions

“The Commonwealth” shall mean the Commonwealth of Australia as established under this Act.--- each of such parts of the Commonwealth shall be called “a State.”

Original States shall mean such States as are parts of the Commonwealth at its establishment.
