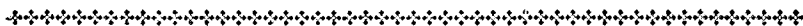

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,

- I. By deleting the words “the war in which His Majesty was engaged and which commenced on the fourth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, and which shall be deemed to have terminated on the tenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty,” in paragraph II. of subsection (1) of section twenty-eight, and substituting therefor the words “any war in which His Majesty is or may be or has been engaged”:
- II. By adding at the end of paragraph II. of subsection (1) of section twenty-eight the words “: Provided that a person who has served in His Majesty’s forces as provided by this paragraph shall be qualified to be enrolled and to vote under this section notwithstanding that he has not attained the age of twenty-one years.”.
